How Does This Work?

You refer customers to DentedWeb.com for web design.

You are paid 20% commission on the entire amount the customer pays for their website.

The customer will receive an invoice, which is also copied to you so you will be able to confirm how much the customer is being billed.

As soon as the customer makes a payment, you are given the full amount of 20% on total cost of their website. Example: If the customer's website will cost \$3,000.00 and the company agrees to accept half down and have paid over the next 6 months. As an Independent Contractor you will receive the full \$600.00 commission (20%) when the client makes their down payment.

How Will I Get Paid?

We require all Independent Contractors to set up a PayPal account. This way we can send the money to you immediately, online.

We don't want you to wait for your money... and we don't want to write checks that can get lost in the mail. By setting up a PayPal account you can have access to your commission minutes after we receive the payment.

In special cases, we are willing to send checks via the mail the first few times you send referrals to the company. But, you are expected to set up a PayPal account as soon as possible. PayPal is free and easy to set up, but if you need any help getting it started, feel free to call us.

How Much Will This Cost Me?

Nothing. This is **not** an investment opportunity. As an Independent Contractor, you simply refer customers to DentedWeb and we give you 20% of what we bill them as soon as they make a payment. There is nothing more to it and you will NEVER be asked to invest money in our company.

What Is The Contractor Agreement Form?

The contractor Agreement Form is there to protect both you and the company. It basically states that you are responsible for reporting and filing your own taxes.

If you want to test this process before signing the form, that's fine. Make a few sales, then when you see how well this works for you send the form. Any commission due you will be paid the same day the signed form is received; (faxed copy or original).
